

Computer, Projectors, and Displays

- Kate provides her own Apple MacBook Pro 14” running macOS Monterey with Thunderbolt 3 (USB-C) and HDMI ports
- Kate’s entire presentation is from her computer using a 16:9 display ratio.
- Clients must provide a DSAN Perfect Cue system (or equivalent) for Kate’s direct slide control. For smaller venues with less than a 75-foot range, Kate will use her own remote slide control device.



- **Microphone**

Please provide a wireless lavalier microphone connected to a professional audio system.

- **Audio**

Audio can be output from Kate’s MacBook Pro via the HDMI, Thunderbolt 3/USB-C ports or a standard 3.5mm analog headphone jack. Note – Kate often uses videos in her presentation and having audio is a requirement unless otherwise agreed.

- **AV Testing / Soundcheck**

Kate requires an AV check no fewer than 30 minutes before the event—ideally, 60 minutes before the event.

- **Confidence Monitors**

Kate prefers a confidence monitor for large audiences. She will not need one for a smaller intimate venue.

- **No Podium**

Kate prefers no podium on stage.

- **No Internet Access**

Kate presents using her own laptop with all videos, audio, and content embedded in the presentation. Therefore, no internet access is needed.

- **Beverage**

Please have a bottle of water available for Kate while she is on stage.
